Semester begins January 17, 2012. Deadline for early registration is January 6, 2011. All new student applications received after the 6th will incur a \$50 late fee added to the non-refundable application fee.

## Craft Training Program

The ABC New Orleans/Bayou Chapter Craft Training Program is accredited by the National Center for Construction Education and Research. The curriculum that we use, Contren Learning Series, was developed by subject matter experts from the industry to train skilled workers.

Campus is open four nights per week for training and classes generally run two nights per week for each trainee. Training is aimed at teaching the skills and knowledge needed in the commercial and industrial sector. Many of our trainees work for contractors in local plants and businesses.

All craft areas offered consist of three to four levels. Levels typically correspond to a year's worth of training. Upon completion of a level, trainees receive certificates of recognition as well as transcripts recognizing the modules successfully completed.

The ABC New Orleans/Bayou Chapter Training Center's primary goal is to provide the construction industry with the most qualified craftsmen today and for years to come.
